

\$50,000 TEXAS ROUND UP SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2010 TGA Round Up Sprint Championship

at Gulf Greyhound Park

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- All rules and regulations of the Texas Racing Commission and the conditions below will apply.
- All greyhounds not racing at Gulf Greyhound Park (GGP) at the time of the stakes must be in the area in time to comply with Texas Racing Commission Rules regarding licensing, etc., and for official schooling, if necessary.
- Those that have not raced officially in the last 30 calendar days must school twice.
- The field will be determined by the Racing Secretary of Gulf Greyhound Park.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- This event is open to any certified Texas Bred Greyhound.
- All applications must be received by GGP no later than **May 7, 2010**.
- All greyhounds must be accompanied by the original registration paper, past performance lines of the last six races, completed NGA lease or lease form available from GGP, proof of vaccinations as mandated by the Texas Racing Commission, and addresses and tax ID number of the registered owner and kennel owner.
- Efforts will be made to guard Kennels and Owners from multiple entries until the final rounds.
- GGP reserves the right to refuse any entry.

QUALIFYING AND RACING CONDITIONS

- All races will be contested over the 550-yard course.
- All elimination rounds will pay AA distance purse.
- The eight greyhounds earning the highest number of points in the four preliminary rounds will comprise the field for the final. Points will accumulate to the final.

- Points will be awarded in the qualifying rounds as follows:
12 points for win
9 points for second
7 points for third
5 points for fourth
3 points for fifth
2 points for sixth
1 points for seventh
0 points for eighth

In the event of a dead heat in any position, the total number of points for those places will be divided equally between those greyhounds.

- Any greyhound failing to school or race satisfactorily in the judge's opinion during any qualifying round may be disqualified from further competition.
- After the second, third, and fourth rounds the field will be cut by the Racing Secretary.
- Greyhounds must compete in all the qualifying rounds to be eligible for the final.
- In a situation when a cut is made, ties will be decided by the most number of firsts, seconds, or thirds, respectively, that the greyhound has earned in the stake. If this fails to break the tie, the best individual race time posted by the greyhound in the qualifying rounds will be used. If this fails to break the tie, the Racing Secretary will draw by lot.
